





Aspects of cultural heritage:

How does Denmark cope with our cultural heritage in regard to both definitions and strategies of preservation? Does preservation of the built environment have to build on what appears as delicate material reconstruction, or could more radical methods be enabled to reveal what is beneath the surface? Furthermore, how do we select buildings for preservations in a more nuanced way to avoid a rapid eradication of the recent history of rural everyday life?

Structure and density in the rural village:

To what extent does the offset of the individual building go beyond its physical boundaries, and how does it impact on the rural village as whole, when several buildings are demolished from one day to another?

Narratives of place:

Could buildings be preserved, within contested rural village communities, as a strengthened collective memory in the form of exchanged narratives of buildings? What is the minimum need to link the narratives to a certain place?
